KHARIAR (AUTONOMOUS) COLLEGE, AT A GLANCE

Khariar college was established on the auspicious day of Vijay Dasami on 21st of October, 1977.

Having affiliated to Sambalpur University, the college began with only 67 students. It got permanent government concurrence in 1979 for IA & in 1980 for BA. In 1986, the college shifted to its present new building, built on the donated plot by RANI SAHIBA Soubhagya Manjari Devi which comprises of a land area of 30.25 Acres. The new campus is name Braj Raj Vihar. This institution having accredited by NAAC & got Autonomous Status from the session 2012-13. Now the college is affiliated to Kalahandi University after disaffiliation from Sambalpur University in the year 2020-21.

At present the college has Arts, Science and Commerce at the +3 level with Honours in all affiliated subjects. Post Graduate courses have been opened

from the Session 2019-20 in Hindi, Odia, Political Science & Chemistry. Special coaching beyond the class hours is provided to the students at the +3 level. There are scope to acquire Certificate Courses in addition to Degree and Diploma.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. The Academic Session of the College commences from June to May.
- 2. Admission into different classes begins from a date stipulated by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Odisha. The admission is done through Common Application Form (e-Admission)
- 3. The date of commencement of classes is to be notified by the Principal in accordance with the instructions from the Govt. of Odisha.
- 4. IDENTITY CARD: Every student must keep with him/her/ his/her Identity Card issued by the Principal and produce it whenever required by the college authorities. If the Identity Card of student is lost he/she should immediately apply for a duplicate Identity Card.
- 5. BICYCLE: Bicycle must be padlocked and kept in the place meant for the said purpose. Cycles should not be kept in the college Verandah.
- 6. PRIVATE CLUBS OR TEAMS: Students of the college are forbidden (i) to participate in any outside athletic/club or any club or society which is not approved by the Government. (ii) to play for any team other than college team. in case a student participates in other than a college team, prior written permission of the Principal is mandatory. Permission to accompany with the college team, when a match is to be played away from Khariar, members of the tam must obtain previous leave of absence from the Principal. Such students living in college hostel must also obtain permission of the hostel superintendent.
- 7. DISCIPLINE: a) students should sincerely attend their classes and should strictly follow the dress-code prescribed by the college authorities.

- b) Students must not spit on walls, floors, pillars or doors & windows of the college. Scribbling and disfiguring the college walls, black-boards, doors & windows are strictly prohibited.
- c) Students are prohibited from loitering in the college corridors when they have no classes to attend. They should spend their leisure hours in the common room or at the reading room.
- d) Students are warned against tampering with the electrical and water-tap fittings.
- e) Continuous absence from the college without leave application will be treated as serious breach of college discipline. Appearing at the unit tests held by the college is mandatory for all the students.
- f) Students must at all places and particularly in the college or playground or while attending meetings must conduct themselves with a sense of decorum.
- g) Students should have their Identity card with them at the time of College examination and other functions.

EXAMINATIONS:-

- a) A total number of 6 Semester (Term End) Examination will be conducted over the period of 3 years for UG & 4 semester (Term End) Examination for PG students 2 years.
- b) No student whose name is not registered with the Kalahandi University shall be eligible to appear at the University/Semester Examinations.
- c) Every examinee has to produce the evidence of having passed the previous qualifying examination during form fill up. He/She has to produce also a certificate of (i) good conduct, (ii) having satisfactorily

passed the periodical Unit Tests and other tests conducted by the college.

MIGRATION CERTIFICATE

A student seeking to take admission under Kalahandi University in case of transfer from other Universities other than CHSE, Odisha shall have to produce Migration Certificate from the said Council.

COLLEGE EXAMINATION RULES

- a) There will be monthly tests ordinarily towards the last week of every month. They will be called Unit Tests. Promotion of the students to the next higher class will be decided by the Staff Council on the basis of the performance of the students in such test.
- b) It is mandatory for the students to appear at all the Unit Tests. Non-appearance in Unit Tests will debar the student from promotion to next higher class and /or filling up form for the final examination.
- c) In case of exigencies such as medical reasons the absentee student will have to produce and authentic Medical Certificate from a registered Medical Practitioner. In case of approved absentees, their progress & promotion will be judged from the marks obtained in other examination.
- d) Malpractice or misconduct in any form during examination will be seriously viewed. Students on such grounds are liable to punishment in the form of fine or detention or both as may be decided by the staff council.
- e) As per the Lyngdoh committee a candidate has to attend 75% of attendance to appear the exam.

LIBRARY RULES

- The library is open to all the members of the staff and students of the college for general use. Members of the college Governing Body and persons specially permitted by the Principal may also use the library according to rules laid down by the Principal from time to time.
- 2. The librarian will see that the rules of discipline are strictly observed.

BOOK BANK RULES

- The college Book Bank has mainly text books on all the subjects taught in the college and is primarily meant for poor and deserving students. Such students will get the benefit of book bank on application to the Principal.
- 2. Students will have to deposit $1/4^{th}$ or $1/8^{th}$ of the price of the book as the case may be before being issued books to him/her.
- 3. The borrowers are entitles to retain the books for a full academic session and must return the books immediately before filling up forms for the university examination.
- 4. Any student who has books from the library (General or Book Bank) outstanding against his/her name will not be allowed to fill up form for the UG/PG examination.

Students are provided with a well – maintained Reading room. They are also provided with News papers, Journals & Periodicals. Use of the Reading room requires maintenance of proper discipline and decorum.

SCHOLARSHIP AND AIDS

- 1. - e) The Govt. of India through the State Government awards scholarships to the blind, deaf and other differently able students and students whose parent are physically challenged.

- g) Hindi Scholarship for Non-Hindi students who have securing 60% in Hindi. h) Scholarship for Minority Communities.
